### 1. Scholarships Available

We offer scholarships to students who have good academic records and demonstrate a positive attitude towards learning. There are four types of scholarships: one for high marks, one for perfect attendance, one for persistence and diligence, and one which is given through an international educational institution.

### 2. High Quality Lessons

Individuals who have completed senior high schools, or the equivalent (education 12 years or more), with diploma.

### 3. Required Documentation

- Application form (prescribed by our school)
- · Personal records and purpose of applicant
- 5 photographs (3 cm X 4 cm, taken within 3 months)
- Diploma or certificate of graduation issued by the last school.
- Transcript issued by the last school.
- Copy of passport (if possible)
- · Certificate of studying Japanese.
- · Certificate of JLPT or BJT, NAT-TEST, J.TEST, GNK.
  - (1) Self payment
- Document of applicant's bank account balance (amount equivalent to JPY 2.2 million)
- · Occupation document issued by his/her company.
  - (2) Others (parents or relatives)
- · Oath for Payment of Expenses. (prescribed by our school)
- Document of bank account balance in the name of guarantor (amount equivalent to JPY 2.2 million)
- Document to prove relationship with the applicant.

### **Accommodation**

Capacity	About 100 students. (6 places) Each room is for two persons. (No single room)
Location	Within 2 minutes' ~ 30 minutes' walk from TCC.
Rental Fees	29,000yen ~ 38,000yen per month.  Water, lighting & heating and gas expenses excluded, and 500 yen service charge per month.
