### 1. Scholarships Available

We offer scholarships to students who have good academic records and demonstrate a positive attitude towards learning. There are four types of scholarships: one for high marks, one for perfect attendance, one for persistence and diligence, and one which is given through an international educational institution.

#### 2. High Quality Lessons

Experienced teachers give detailed lessons starting with the basics. Our curriculum and methods will enable students to pass the highest level of Japanese proficiency tests, and prepare them for university entrance exams.

To assure that students are on their appropriate level or grade, we follow a strict pass/fail grading system, and can give supplementary lessons, if necessary. We also allow students to advance or skip levels.

### APPLICATION GUIDANCE

### 1. Eligibility

Individuals who have completed senior high school, or the equivalent (education 12 years or more), with diploma.

#### 2. Application Procedure

Application should be sent to TCC Japanese Institute 5-28-4, Arai, Nakano-Ku, 165-0026, Tokyo, Japan

Deadline

April enrollments : from Aug. 1 to Sep. 30
July enrollments : from Dec. 1 to Jan. 31
Oct. enrollments : from Mar 1 to Apr.30.

### 3. Required Documentation

- Application form (prescribed by our school)
- Personal records and purpose of applicant
- 5 photographs (3 cm X 4 cm, taken within 3 months)
- Diploma or certificate of graduation issued by the last school attended.
- Transcript issued by the last school attended.
- Copy of passport
- · Certificate of studying Japanese.
- · Certificate of JLPT or BJT, NAT-TEST, J.TEST, GNK.
  - (1) Self payment
- Document of applicant's bank account balance (amount equivalent to JPY 2.2 million)
- Occupation document issued by his/her company.
  - (2) Others (parents or relatives)
- · Oath for Payment of Expenses. (prescribed by our school)
- Document of bank account balance in the name of guarantor (amount equivalent to JPY 2.2 million)
- Document to prove relationship with the applicant.
- Occupation document issued by the company or business permit issued by some public organization.
